

Paint Masking Technician

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Paint Masking Technician shall apply masking on all parts as required per the customer's blueprint or operations sheet. Technician will alert department manager of any supply shortages of masking supplies.

DUTIES:

- Maintain a clean masking room which is presentable to visitors at all times.
- Ensure that all parts are masked per the customer's blueprint or operations sheet.
- Maintain clean ovens and paint booth, at the request of department manager.
- Assist in racking and unranking parts for paint after anodize.
- Assist in maintaining paint department racking.
- Comply with all TAG housekeeping.
- Locate masking operation sheets and necessary customer prints and specifications.
- Understand customer requirements as it applies to the masking of blind and through holes using high temperature silicon plugs or required masking tape.
- Protect and store masked parts in the proper storage area (i.e. padded shelves) prior to receiving paint.
- Remove masking material and visually inspect parts for obvious imperfections from painted surfaces.
- Complete paperwork accurately.
- Self report errors, seek assistance, be factual & reliable to help build and maintain the positive reputation and integrity of the department.
- Assist other departments as time permits.

TRAINING PERIOD:

- 90 days
- Must pass drug/alcohol test
- Must pass background check
